The NOMS interviews help us learn about the impact of mental health treatments so we can make them work better for children and families. They are interviews about how the child is doing in different areas, including in dealing with emotions, in school, and with friends.

Enrollment

Approach client about NOMS interviews. Provide client with:

- Client Brochure
- Participation Agreement (MUST BE SIGNED BEFORE ANY OTHER DATA IS COLLECTED)

Clinicians that provide services will complete an interview that takes about 30 minutes with student or caregiver.

Baseline Interview

Must be completed within 7 days of enrollment

Complete Baseline Interview with client using NOMS interview tool through Qualtrics.

6 Month Interview

Must be completed within 30 days on either side of the assessment due date, providing a 60-day window for completion

Complete the NOMS interview using NOMS follow-up/discharge section:

- Services Received
- Provide any updates to Behavioral Health Diagnosis

Discharge

Must be completed at discharge or within 2 weeks of discharge if client is available

Complete the NOMS interview using NOMS follow-up/discharge section:

- Discharge Status
- Services Received

Provide any updates to Behavioral Health Diagnosis
