- Children's Behavioral Health Coalition's 2023 Agenda for Maryland's General Assembly is focusing on
 - repairing communities that use High Fidelity Wraparound
 - adding more early intervention programs
 - ending discriminatory care practices against LGBTQ youth and young adults
 - creating better access to community-based treatments
- Maryland's legislation has been meeting this month to try and pass a new public health bill. This bill is looking to provide funding to help create better mental health and drug treatment. Advocates of mental health are also hoping that it would better community behavioral health clinics.
- On February 15, there will be a briefing in Annapolis that goes over more legislation for behavioral health in Maryland from the General Assembly.
