Referral Process

Positive Alternatives for Student Success (PASS)

- 1. The student severely disrupts the learning environment on an ongoing basis or extreme incident(s).
- 2. Documentation of Tier I, Tier II, and Tier III interventions are completed.
- 3. The parent/guardian has been contacted.
- 4. The PASS Documentation Form has been completed.
- 5. The students may be facing or has received an out of school suspension.
- Principal will enter information into Power School Logs.



- 1. The student qualified for the PASS program.
- 2. The team identifies behavior that needs to improve. (1-3 behaviors)



- 1. If the parent/guardian declines placement in PASS, then:
- 2. The students is placed in out of school suspension, or:
- 3. The parent/guardian makes alternative arrangements for student's education.
