- 6. What are your school's current policies that would reinforce or inform the teacher's response?
- 1. Why do you think the 15 year old took his gun out? Was this stranger a threat to the 15 year old?
- 2. Without knowing what is going on with the student what consequences do you think the school will give to the 15 year old?
- 3. If the school knew the impact of trauma, in what way could they respond to help the student?
- Create a plan of action to respond to the student for your school. Include what school and community resources you have available to you.

  - 2. As a school social worker how would you respond?
