II. State Plan Amendment Regulatory Updates for 1915(i) (Rebecca Raggio, Chief of Medicaid Behavioral Health Division, Maryland Department of Health)

- Reviewed regulation changes for children and youth targeted case management and for 1915i youth behavioral health support services, including background on the proposed changes and implementation timeframe – slides will be shared.
- Note that any jurisdiction without IIHS, providers can still enroll youth in 1915i for other bundled services; BHA and Carelon actively recruiting new providers – interested providers are encouraged to read all requirements carefully, outlined on the Carelon website. - Question re. differentiating youth who's 18-21 getting youth vs adult services -youth must access services before age 18 to continue receiving youth-specific services through age 22, given no large breaks in service. If someone first seeks services at 18–22, they must use adult services instead.
